### DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO MIS HISTORIC LEARNING CENTER

**Bldg. 640. 640 Mason Street, Presidio of San Francisco, CA 94129**

*From Japantown:*

1. Head East on Post St. Left on Franklin.
2. Go down Franklin. Turn Left on Bay St. At the stop light, right on Laguna, Quick left on Marina.
3. Follow Marina Blvd. toward the Presidio – Crissy Field West. Enter the Presidio entrance (stay in right hand lane).
4. Continue into the Presidio on Mason St. to Sports Basement (pass on left).
5. Turn left into Sports Basement parking lot behind Sports Basement, & walk one block to Bldg. 640. Or you can double-back past Bldg 640 and park along Mason Street.

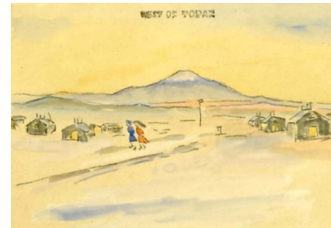

Eaton artworks for an exhibition that was never held. The artifacts were going to be auctioned last year but the sale was cancelled after a nationwide protest.
